Course Information & Teaching Methods;

This course is designed for complete beginners or those who wish to refresh their skills by practising the basics. The course will introduce you to your watercolour kit and cover core techniques like watercolour washes, colour mixing, stretching paper and how to use sketches and choose colours for a successful composition. We will use examples, demonstrations and warm-up exercises to introduce each topic and make paintings starting from landscapes, light and shade and autumn trees. Plenty of individual help will be given throughout the course.

Equipment;

Please do bring any watercolour materials which you already have, although some watercolour paints will be available to borrow.

Paper is available to purchase in the art room.

The tutor will provide brushes to borrow for the first session and advice will be given for purchasing your own. If you do this before the course, please make sure they are of a good quality.
